The **U.S. Model 1903 Springfield Rifle**, manufactured 1903 to 1945, this rifle replaced the Krag-Jorgensen and was the primary U.S. battle rifle until 1936, when it was replaced by the M1 Garand. Some variation of the '03 rifle saw service all the way into the early stages of the Vietnam War, where it was still utilized as a sniper rifle in the form of the 1903A4.
